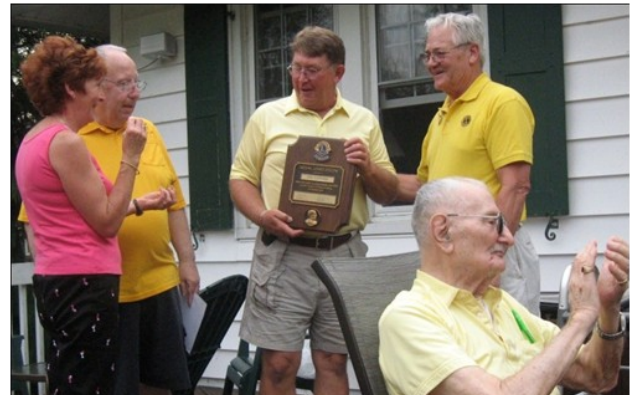
The Millerton Lions honored scholarship winners, inducted 2 new members, and installed officers at a recent dinner.
